Re: Safety announcement on contaminated radiation

We would like to express our deepest thanks for your all concerns about the disaster on occurred in East-northern Japan on 11th March 2011.

VST has re-started our operation at the factory in Zao in east-northern Japan which had minor damage by the earthquake.

We report the status of company safety and the future measures on nuclear radiation.

Status on contaminated radiation

I Evacuation zone at Fukushima nuclear power plant

Circle in the Map below shows evacuation and stay-indoor zone.

Upper point in red shows our Zao factory.



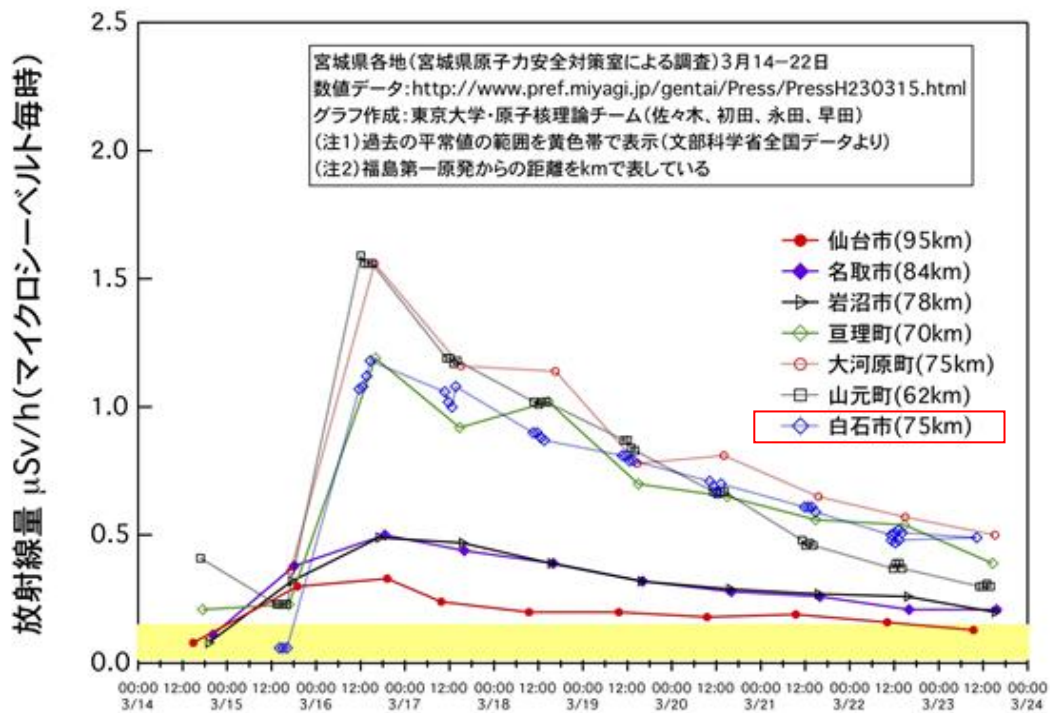
II Radiation level in Zao in Shiraishi city area

As of 22nd March: Radiation level in Shiraishi city (red-color framed) has been decreased at 0.5~0.7 μ Sv/h

- Normal level in a year: 2.4mSv/y (2,400 μ Sv/y)
- Taking a breast X-ray for health check: 6.9mSv (6,900 μ Sv)
- Flight between Tokyo and New York: 0.2mSv (200 μ Sv)



Future measures of VST on radiation safety

Products inspection by radiation measurement instruments

We will install a radiation measurement instruments which is able to measure up to 9.99Sv/h. It is planned to start on 18th April to measure on products at Zao factory before shipment along with the official announcement by Japan government and IAEA.

Note: No contamination danger from products produced in our other factories in China, Hong Kong and Philippines.

We will work unceasingly to confirm all safety on our products and services.
